There is a need to strengthen the elected representatives for their role and responsibilities in Panchayats as per 73rd & 74th Constitution Amendment. Panchayat Finance and various Developmental Schemes, Right to Information Act, Rules of Business & Procedure of Panchayats, skills for Development works and Gender Sensitisation etc. are the topics of main concerned in this course.
